#### **Arizona Tax Credit**

Because Habitat for Humanity qualifies as an eligible charity, donations to Habitat are eligible for a dollar-for-dollar tax credit up to \$400 for individual and \$800 for joint filers.

#### To Claim the Credit You Must:

- Be an Arizona resident
- Complete Arizona tax form 321 to file with your state tax return.
- Postmark contributions or make them online by April 15<sup>th</sup>.

#### Do I have to itemize to claim Charitable Tax Credits?

No, You do not have to itemize deductions to claim a credit for contributions.

Can I take the Working Poor Tax credit if I take the School Tax Credit?

Yes, they are separate credits and you are allowed to take advantage of both.

# What to expect:

## **Build Site Safety Overview:**

The job site is a place full of activity. Be aware of your surroundings at all times. You are responsible for your own safety as well as the safety of others. If you see something unsafe notify a Team Leader immediately. Please note the following:

- No one under 16 years old is permitted on or around the active construction site.
- All volunteers must complete the volunteer waiver prior to participating in construction.
- Volunteers should carry medical ID and emergency contact information.



# **Roof and Ladder Safety:**

- Exercise caution when utilizing a ladder. Ensure ladder is on a stable surface.
- Use a partner to steady a ladder.
- Ensure A-frame ladders are fully extended.
- Do not lean or reach for items when on a ladder move the ladder instead.
- When on the roof, move slowly and carefully. Never walk backwards.
- Never lay anything down on the roof. Tools and other objects can slide and fall off, injuring others.
- Be aware of people working above and below you.

# What to bring:

- Water bottle (water will be available on site as well).
- Sun block and sun protection (hat, sweat rag, etc...).
- Lunch/Snack (check with your coordinator if lunch will be provided).
- Please leave large items like purses and backpacks in your car or at home.

### **Tool Safety:**

- Always follow specific directions from site leaders regarding the safe use and operation of tools.
- Safety glasses are required when using power tools.
- Inspect the cords, outlets, and blades before using.
- · Do not disable any safety features.

# **Lifting and Carrying Items**

- When lifting, stand close to the load, bend your knees, use a firm grasp, and lift by straightening your legs.
- Keep your back straight and your body vertical.
- Get help with heavy or long loads.
