Christ the King Sunday November 20, 2022

Jeremiah's promise of the execution of "justice and righteousness in the land" finds ironic fulfillment in the execution of Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews. It appears utterly contradictory that a king should be crucified with a criminal. This victory appears for all the world as humiliating defeat. Yet through the gate of death Jesus opens the door to paradise.

Question for Reflection: Jesus speaks of wars, insurrections, earthquakes, famines, and plagues, but instructs his followers, "Do not be terrified!" How does our s=witness to the gospel include resistance to our natural impulse to be terrorized by evil? Have you ever suffered persecution as a Christian because you refused to go along with social pressure to be fearful of enemies, terrorist, criminals, illegal aliens, or other pariahs?

Morning Prayer: Lord of Creation, every morning you renew the earth with light. I praise for you the morning light, and I rejoice in the life you have given me. Let me be a friend to those who do not know your love. Let e offer hope to those who do not trust your goodness. Let me embody graciousness to those who do not understand your peace. Help me to be a blessing to all I encounter- to bear witness to your goodness through Jesus Christ. Amen.

Evening Prayer: Lord, the day is done and my labors must end. I trust to your care all that I have done and all that I have left undone, for you alone are my strength. Give me peaceful rest that I may raise to faithful service, with Jesus Christ my Lord. Amen.


