## **ELCA Region 2 Lenten Challenge for Hunger**

About 11% of the world's population is hungry. In honor of the ELCA World Hunger's 50<sup>th</sup> year in mission and ministry, the five synods in ELCA's Region 2 are challenging one another to raise money for ELCA World Hunger. The synods are Grand Canyon, Rocky Mountain, Pacifica, Southwest California, and Sierra Pacific. The challenge involves participating in spiritual and physical practices during the 40 days of Lent. The intent is to consider the following four Lenten practices and commit to three:

1. Daily Devotion: Subscribe to receive daily email devotions for Lent.

- 2. Daily Discipline: Do one wellness activity every day.
- 3. Daily Declutter: Once a day find a way to declutter, de-stress, and re-tune.
- 4. Daily Donation: Pledge to give \$1 a day or more.

Esperanza's Outreach Team is partnering with Desert Cross Lutheran Church, 8600 E McClintock Drive, Tempe, to serve the Interfaith Homeless Emergency Lodging Program (I-HELP). This ministry provides shelter nights to homeless adults as well as a case management program that assists with finding employment. Our next serving opportunity is Tuesday, March 26, from 4:30 to 7 p.m. The experience includes providing dinner and making sack lunches for the following day. Volunteers are needed to prepare and bring food for dinner, serve guests, and participate in mealtime activities. Signups have begun, and we anticipate a need for 10 to 15 volunteers to serve 27 guests.
