What to wear:

- Jeans or long shorts please no short shorts or tank tops.

- Habitat is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or misplaced items.

What to bring:

- Bottled water, we will have some water on site.
- Snacks if desired.
- Sunscreen and hats are highly recommended.

While Habitat will provide all necessary tools and protective gear on-site, you are welcome to bring your own if you like. If you do bring your own supplies, you are responsible for removing them from the site at the end of the day.

For those that can volunteer on **Tuesdays** we will begin at 7:30 AM Tuesday January 3rd and again on January 10th to do the prep work to get ready for erecting walls on the 14th.
