On Good Friday, April 7, 2023 from 7 am to 6 pm (except 12 pm – 1 pm) at Mountain View Lutheran Church (in the Worship Center), 11002 S. 48th Street, Phoenix, AZ 85044. The "Way of the Cross" is a self-guided time of meditation and prayer
