Esperanza's Outreach Team is partnering with Desert Cross Lutheran Church, 8600 E McClintock Drive, Tempe, to serve the Interfaith Homeless Emergency Lodging Program (I-HELP). This ministry provides shelter nights to homeless adults as well as a case management program that assists with finding employment. Special Congregation Meeting on April 21, 2024 (following the 9AM service) to approve proposed changes to the Esperanza Constitution, Bylaws and Continuing Resolutions. Over the past couple of years, questions and concerns have been raised regarding some of the wording and content of our constitution. So, in May of 2023, the council began the process of reviewing our constitution, bylaws and continuing resolutions to see what changes should be recommended to the congregation. The Congregation Council recommendations are incorporated into this document and based on research from ELCA congregations, the Grand Canyon Synod, the Office of the Secretary of the ELCA and the Office of the Archivist of the ELCA.

The following two attachments include:

- The proposed Esperanza Constitution. Bylaws, and Continuing Resolutions clearly showing changes proposed.
- Rationale for each of these changes.

There are copies of these documents on The Narthex table now to give you a chance to read and study the changes prior to the Congregation Meeting on Sunday, April 21, 2024, following the 9AM service. There will be a Q&A session on Sunday, April 14, **2024** following the 9AM service to allow for discussion and questions that you might have. We will be following the process of approving amendments to the proposed changes as described in Section 16 of our constitution. In summary, it states that a simple majority is required for approval at the April 21st meeting of the proposed changes. The approved changes will then be ratified at our next regularly scheduled congregation meeting -May 19th, 2024 - by a two-thirds vote of those voting members present and voting. The approved and ratified changes will then be sent to the Grand Canyon Synod for their review. Upon approval, they will notify us of their approval. The changes will go into effect once we have received their notification.
