Matthew Shepard (December 1, 1976—October 12, 1998), a gay college student at the University of Wyoming, was beaten, tortured, and left to die near Laramie, Wyoming the night of October 6, 1998. Six days later, he died from severe head injuries received during the attack. The two men who assaulted him were charged with first degree murder. Shepard's murder brought attention to hate crime legislation so that, in 2009, Congress passed and President Obama signed into law the Matthew Shepard and James Byrd Jr. Hate Crimes Prevention Act. The red rose on the altar today as well as the pieces sung by the choir are in memory of Matthew Shepard on the 25th anniversary of his death.
